Dear Parents/Carers.

As part of our science topic, animals and their offspring, Year 2 have the opportunity to visit Noverton Farm to see their newborn lambs and other animals. The farmer will also be taking the children on a tour to give them an understanding of where food comes from and the workings of a modern farm.

**2H will visit the farm on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April.**

**2P will visit the farm on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> April.**

This trip is possible through the help of the educational charity, Countryside Learning, which gets children out into the countryside. They have a farm membership group called Farms for Schools, with trusted farms that do visits for schools.

The visit to the farm is free of charge however, we do need to cover the cost of the coach travel and are asking for a voluntary contribution of £9.75.

Mrs Pates and I are visiting the farm over the Easter holidays. We will advise on what appropriate footwear and clothing is required, via a Seesaw message, when we return after the holidays.
