Read Write Inc.

Some of the information that is shared in this newsletter regarding Read Write Inc. may not be relevant to your child and is dependent on which term they started Nursery.

The children will be continuing the Read Write Inc. phonics scheme. Your child will have homework on Seesaw and bring home a sound sheet once they have been taught a new sound. We would like you to support your child with their phonics by practising the sounds with them at home.

Please cut off the sound card in the top righthand corner of the sound sheets so you can build up your own flashcards to use with your child. These can be used to revise the sounds that they have learned previously. Please return the completed sound sheets in your child's book bag.







Forest School

Forest School sessions will begin again this term. Letters have been given out stating which group and dates your child will attend. Please note that Thursday Forest School session has now moved to a Wednesday.

Story Sharing

Library books will be changed on a **Wednesday**. The children are required to **bring their book bag every day**. Book bags and reading diaries are checked daily by staff. There will be reading challenges throughout the term, and it would be lovely if lots of the children received a special certificate.

PΕ

This term, the children will be needing to wear their PE kits for our PE sessions. PE sessions are on Mondays and Thursdays. If your child attends Nursery on these days, please can you send them to Nursery in their PE kit. They will need navy or black shorts, a white T-shirt and pumps or trainers (velcro trainers are preferable).

Please ensure that all items are named.

Outdoor Learning

As the weather gets warmer, please send your child with a **named sunhat** for outdoor learning and apply sun cream **before coming to Nursery** when required.



Parent Pop-In

Our next parent pop-in will focus will on phonics. There will be phonics activities for you to share with your child and ideas shared that you can use at home. More details will follow shortly.

Toys

Just a reminder that we do not allow toys from home to be brought to Nursery. This is because they could get lost or damaged and this causes upset.

Naming personal belongings

Please can you double check that all items (including shoes, wellies, clothing, lunch bags and water bottles) are clearly labelled with your child's name. It is very easy for items to get lost if they are not named.

Nursery Wraparound

Nursery wraparound is available every weekday from 7.30am until 6.00pm. Booking is done through the school office. This will be held in the Nursery and will be staffed by the Nursery team.
