We will work hard to identify how we can edit and improve our work, allowing us to grow as writers.</p>		<p>Maths As mathematicians, we will be working on geometry, including angles, properties of triangles and quadrilaterals and direction and movement. Our daily lessons will be split into 3 parts; try it, twist it and deepen it. This allows the children to develop their fluency skills and apply them to reasoning and problem-solving activities.</p>

They will deliver an engaging and fun curriculum to inspire children to think and create music like a musician.</p>
<p>History As historians, we will be studying the local area, exploring how it has changed over time.</p>	<p>Geography As geographers, we will gain knowledge on the impact and scale that pollution is having on the world, both on land in our oceans.</p>		<p>My Life As citizens of the Burlish community, we will be thinking about relationships.
