









Burlish Park Primary Nursery Spring Term Newsletter

The Nursery Team would like to say Happy New Year to all our children and their families.

<p>Reading Your child will bring a library book home to share with their family. Library books will be changed on a Wednesday. The children are required to bring their book bag every day. Book bags and reading diaries are checked daily by staff.</p>	<p>Writing and Mark Making</p>  <p>This term we will continue to provide the children with lots of opportunities to develop their fine motor skills through various activities. We will be focusing on the correct pencil grip and writing their name.</p>	<p>Maths This term we will be focussing on counting objects, sounds and actions. We will also be developing the children's skill of linking a numeral with its corresponding number of objects.</p> 		
<p>Books to Support Our Topics</p> 	<p>Phonics We will continue to develop the children's phonological awareness through activities such as, syllable clapping, listening for and recognising initial sounds in familiar words. We will also begin learning initial sounds using the Read Write Inc. scheme. A booklet will be sent via Seesaw explaining about the scheme.</p>			
<p>RE The festivals and celebrations we will be learning about this term are: Chinese New Year Ramadan Easter</p>	<p>Topics The topics we will be covering over the Spring term are:</p>	<p>It's cold outside I wonder how things change in Winter?</p> 	<p>Time for Tea I wonder how will it be different?</p> 	<p>All Aboard I wonder what we will see?</p> 
<p>Forest School Forest School sessions will be on Tuesday and Friday mornings. These sessions will be delivered in groups of 12-15 children. Group 1 will attend the first half term and Group 2 will attend after half term.</p>	<p>Outdoor Learning All the children have the opportunity to learn outdoors. We go out in all weathers, to take part in activities which support the children's learning across the Foundation Stage curriculum. Your child will need a pair of named wellies to keep at Nursery. Please send these in as soon as possible.</p>		<p>PE PE sessions will be on Monday and Friday mornings. They will take place in the main school hall. Please send your child to school in navy or black jogging bottoms/leggings and a white polo shirt for these sessions, every week. We will be focusing on their throwing and catching skills.</p>
