Consent Forms for Unaccompanied Departure (Years 5 & 6)



In Years 5 and 6 you *may* consider your child old enough to walk home unaccompanied by an adult.



It is very important that staff are aware of those children who have permission to walk home alone and those who do not. This will enable us to direct children to the appropriate area for collection by parents or dismissal to walk.

If you wish your child to walk home unaccompanied, please complete the form below and return it to school during the first week back.

Class teachers will not allow children to leave on their own if your written consent has not been given. At the end of the day children will leave the school and wait in the waiting area at the front of the school, unless we receive your permission for them to leave school unaccompanied.



Pupils in Year 5 or 6 who walk home can bring a mobile phone into school. All phones must be brought in a clean plastic bag and handed in to a specified area on arrival at their class base and collected on departure.

Please note that children in Years 5 and 6 are not considered old enough to escort younger brothers and sisters home and should not be expected to take on the responsibility.

I hope you understand that these precautions are part of our duty of care for the children.
