## Easter Activities

On 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> March the children are invited to take part in various “eggsciting” Easter activities.

Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 can make and wear an Easter bonnet. Parents, carers and relatives are all welcome to watch the children parade around the Key Stage 2 playground at 9am on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> March. The PTA will kindly purchase small prizes to award to the winners from each class.

Key Stage 2 children are invited to create an “Eggshibition” of decorated eggs. Children can decorate an empty eggshell or polystyrene egg using anything to hand e.g. paint, felt tips, glitter, sequins or buttons. They can be even more ambitious and creative and the egg can become a ‘character in a scene’ which can be named. Ideas could include “The Eggs Factor”, “Egg Sheeran” and “Eggerdale Farm”.

**Please use empty eggshells or polystyrene eggs, not full raw eggs, as breakages could easily ruin other people's projects.**

Children should bring their “eggcellent” egg into school with them on the morning of Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> March. It should be labelled with their name and class. They will then be able to display it in the hall.

The “Eggshibtion” can be viewed by parents and carers after school on 29<sup>th</sup> March in the School hall at 3pm.
