Mental Health Week

This week, children have been participating in various activities to help improve their health and wellbeing "inside and out". Pupils have developed their yoga skills, linked healthy eating and being physically active and taking part in mindfulness activities.

Kara, age 10 and Lottie, age 11 said, "When we join in mindfulness activities, it opens our mind and makes us feel relaxed. The NSPCC also visited us and talked to us about who to share any problems and worries with."

Children came up with their 'top tips' to having good mental health, which included being physically active, eating healthily, time to relax, having enough sleep and being able to talk to someone.



Safer Internet Day

This week we have been looking at Safer Internet Day. Children started Tuesday and Wednesday with an assembly where they watched a video about keeping themselves safe online. The main message in the national campaign this year was consent, including that before posting/sharing photos etc. online, you should ensure you have the person's permission.

In school, we also have a huge focus on children telling an adult if something they see online worries them and that they should never share personal details online.

Georgie, age 10, said, "You should be very careful with who you give your details too. Always check with an adult."
