Reading

As readers, we will be exploring a range of texts. The texts will engage and enthuse the children, providing opportunities to infer for meaning, to explore and evaluate how authors use language and ask questions to improve their understanding.

Writing

As writers, we will be composing pieces of work that allow us to showcase our writing skills. We will gain a better understanding of cohesion and develop our ability to edit and improve our work effectively.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be working on place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division. We will continue to practise our recall of our times tables up to 12 x 12. Our daily lessons will be split into 3 parts; Try it, Twist it and Deepen it. This allows the children to develop their fluency skills and apply them to reasoning and problem solving activities.

Spanish

As linguists, we will use spoken language to learn words, phrases and simple sentences. We will also explore information about the country of Spain.

Science

As scientists, we will be exploring Space and Planet Earth. We will have an overarching question for our topic: How have our ideas about Space changed over time?

Computing

As digital creators, we will learn how to compose and record a jingle.

Music

As musicians, we will be taught by a company called Fame. They will deliver an engaging and fun curriculum to inspire children to think and create music like a musician.

History

As historians, we will explore Early Islamic Civilisation. During this unit of work, we will explore Early Islamic Civilisation 570 – 900AD looking at its impact on culture and what parts of the Islamic civilisation culture are still part of modern-day society e.g. Islamic religion, Arabic language and numerals.

Geography

As geographers, we will locate North America and identify the physical and human features. We will explore how natural hazards affect the people of North America.

My Life

As citizens of the Burlish Park community, we will be covering the topics of Body Image and Bereavement and Loss.

Design Technology

As technicians, we will research, design, make and evaluate a fidget blanket for someone with Alzheimer's or Autism to help relieve anxiety or agitation and to aid a feeling of calmness.

Art

As artists, we will use the work of French artist Edgar Degas. We will explore and develop skills of drawing a figure in proportion.

RE

As theologists, we will consider the question Why do Hindus want to be good? and explore Hinduism.

PE

As sportspeople, we will be learning more about Invasion Games through playing Basketball and Netball. We will also be developing our skills in Tchoukball, Pop Lacrosse and Handball.
