Reading

As readers, we will enjoy sharing a collection of books. The books we share offer a range of rich vocabulary and exciting plots. We will use reading strategies to improve comprehension skills and develop writing by taking inspiration from the author's work.

Writing

As writers, we will be creating pieces of work that showcase the skills that we have learnt. We will develop a greater understanding of cohesion and make effective vocabulary choices to enhance meaning and impact. Writing will be used to create a portfolio which will be Teacher Assessed.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will learn written calculation methods and regularly complete arithmetic tasks. Our daily lessons will be split into 3 parts; try it, twist it and deepen it. This allows the children to develop their fluency skills and apply them to reasoning and problem solving activities.

RE

As theologists, we will consider the question What kind of King was Jesus? and explore how faith helps people when life gets hard.

Spanish

As linguists, we will use spoken language to learn words, phrases and simple sentences. We will also explore information about the country of Spain.

Science

As scientists, we will learn about evolution and living things. We will explore how scientific evidence supports or refutes ideas and examples.

Computing

As digital creators, we will plan, code and control a physical computing robotic around a series of challenges by using conditionals, loops and variables.

Music

Music will be taught by Severn Arts through a 'Fame project'. They will deliver an engaging and fun curriculum to inspire children to think and create music like a musician.

History

As historians, we will explore how the role of women changed throughout history and investigate whether there is still more to do.

Geography

As geographers, we will investigate ways that we can make our local area sustainable. We will compile data and complete research to inform an action plan to make our area more efficient when it comes to sustainability.

My Life

During My Life sessions, we will learn about Online Safety and how to manage the pressures of social media. We will also have sessions about the transition to High School.
