CHILDREN

I will do my best to:

PARENTS

To help my child at school, I will do my best to:

- Raise any concerns or problems that might affect my child's ability to learn or behave appropriately

- Support my child with homework, using Seesaw to communicate any issues
- Listen to my child read daily and sign their diaries
- Attend parent meetings with the teacher to discuss my child's achievements and progress
- Support the school in getting any help my child may need
- Read all letters/messages/emails/texts that are sent home
- Inform the school immediately of any changes to parent/carer and emergency contact details
- Provide my child with the correct uniform and equipment they need
- Order their school lunch, if required, through ParentPay
- Respect all members of the school community, abiding by their policy of zero tolerance towards rude and aggressive behaviour
