Last week in our whole school assembly, we introduced the pupils to MEE!

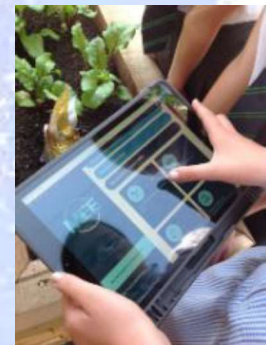
MEE (My Extraordinary Experiences) is a Rivers trust wide programme where all schools in the trust will be offering 20 experiences to the pupils during their time at school.
