








Burlish Park Primary Nursery Summer Term Newsletter

The Nursery Team would like to welcome all our children and their families back after the Easter Holiday.

<p>Reading Your child will bring a library book home to share with their family. Library books will be changed on a Wednesday. The children are required to bring their book bag every day. Book bags and reading diaries are checked daily by staff.</p>	<p>Writing and Mark Making This term we will continue to provide the children with various activities to master their fine motor skills. We will focus on the correct pencil grip, writing their name and the sounds they are learning.</p> 	<p>Maths This term, the children will continue to master the skill of linking a numeral with its corresponding number of objects. We will also be developing the children's skill of subitising.</p> 
<p>Books to Support Our Topics</p> 	<p>Phonics We will continue to develop the children's phonological awareness through activities such as syllable clapping, rhyming words, and listening for and recognising initial sounds in familiar words. We will also continue learning initial sounds using the Read Write Inc. scheme.</p>	
<p>Understanding the World We will be learning about the seed lifecycle. We will be planting sunflowers and runner beans and learning what plants need to grow.</p>	<p>Topics The topics we will be covering over the summer term are:</p> <div data-bbox="774 1097 1101 1355" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin: 10px;"> <p>Down at the bottom of the garden I wonder how things grow and change?</p>  </div>	<p>Superheroes I wonder who will help us?</p> 
<p>Forest School Forest School sessions will be on Tuesday and Thursday mornings. These sessions will be delivered in groups of 12-15 children. Group 1 will attend the first half term and Group 2 will attend after half term. Please ensure your child wears a long sleeved top and bottoms for their sessions.</p>	<p>Outdoor Learning All the children will have the opportunity to learn outdoors. We go out in all weathers, to take part in activities which support the children's learning across the Foundation Stage curriculum. As the weather will hopefully be getting warmer, they will also need a named sun hat.</p>	<p>PE PE sessions will be on Monday and Friday mornings. They will take place in the main school hall or outdoors on the field. Please send your child to school in navy or black jogging bottoms/leggings and a white polo shirt for these sessions, every week. We will be focusing on various skills ready for Sports Day.</p>
