





<p>Reading As readers, we will be exploring a range of texts. The texts will engage and enthuse the children, providing opportunities to infer for meaning, to explore and evaluate how authors use language and ask questions to improve their understanding.</p> 	<p>Writing As writers, we will be composing pieces of work that allow us to showcase our writing skills. We will work hard to identify how we can edit and improve our work, allowing us to grow as writers.</p> 	<p>Maths As mathematicians, we will be working on perimeter and area, statistics, angles and decimals. This allows the children to develop their fluency skills and apply them to reasoning and problem-solving activities.</p> 
	<p>RE As theologians, we will explore why the Torah is important to Jewish people and explore what matters most to Humanists and Christians.</p>	<p>Spanish As linguists, we will use spoken language to learn words, phrases and simple sentences. We will focus on naming countries and continents and talking about where we would like to visit.</p> 
<p>Science As scientists, we will be exploring what kind of changes can be reversed. In Biology, we will look at how the human reproductive system works.</p>	<p>Computing As digital creators, we will be using Scratch to write code and run algorithms to control sprites. We will also be researching the history of computer technology and those responsible for it.</p>	<p>Music As musicians, we will be taught by a company called 'Fame'. They will deliver an engaging and fun curriculum to inspire children to think and create music like a musician.</p>
<p>History As historians, we will be studying what life was like for children in the Victorian era.</p>	<p>Geography As geographers, we will be finding out how flooding impacts people's lives.</p>	<p>My Life As citizens of the Burlish community, we will be thinking about relationships. An additional letter has been sent out to explain this in more detail.</p>
<p>Design Technology As technicians, we will explore the impact of flooding around the world design and build a model of a flood-proof house.</p>	<p>Art As artists, we will explore how different artists have represented the human form over time.</p>	<p>PE As sportspeople we will be learning about Athletics, Striking and Fielding and OAA (Outdoor and Adventurous Activities).</p>
