| <p>Reading As readers, we will focus on our listening skills through a range of exciting texts. We would love the children to continue to read their phonic books to you that are set on Oxford Owl and talk about what they have learnt. As you will already know, we love words and will actively encourage the children to talk about the meanings of these new words.</p>  | <p>Writing As writers, we will continue to focus on our handwriting skills, focusing on forming our letters correctly. We will be developing our sentence writing by adding some adjectives, encouraging the children to write their high frequency words correctly and using our phonic knowledge to spell words. We will also make sure we are still using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.</p>  | <p>Maths As mathematicians, we will be starting to understand the idea of multiplication. We will continue to practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and use this skill to solve simple multiplication problems. We will use physical resources and pictures to help us to really understand this concept. We will learn about division and how we can share numbers into equal groups.</p> |
| <p>Science As scientists, we will be asking the question 'What do I know about plants?' We will learn about the difference between evergreen and deciduous trees, the basic structure of a flowering plant and where seeds grow best.</p> | <p>Computing As digital creators, we will be using labels to put objects into groups and labelling these groups. We will sort objects into different groups, based on the properties the children choose. Finally, pupils will use their ability to sort objects into different groups to answer questions about their data.</p> | <p>Music As musicians, we will be listening to pieces of music about superheroes. We will be learning how to identify high and low notes, composing and performing simple tunes as well as exploring different percussion instruments.</p> |
| <p>History As historians, the children will be asking 'How has transport changed over time?' Children will understand how transport has changed over time and why these changes have happened. Children will explore different types of transport across road, rail, air and space, building knowledge of their features and purposes.</p> | <p>Geography As geographers, the children will be focusing on the driving question 'How can we improve our school environment?' We will be using a compass to help our understanding of direction and will spot examples of human and physical geography within our school environment.</p> | <p>My Life In My Life, we will be looking at the unit 'All around us' which includes looking at our beautiful world, reusing and recycling and understanding that we can all make a difference. We will also look at the unit 'Money Matters' which includes discovering where money comes from and where adults get money from.</p> |
| <p>Design Technology As technicians, we will be looking at levers and sliders. We will develop an understanding of how different mechanisms produce different types of movement.</p> | <p>Art As artists, the children will be learning how to make a sculpture, know how to join materials together using a variety of resources. The children will explore the work of Tricia Griffiths, who is an artist who sculpts.</p> | <p>PE As sportspeople, we will be practising our athletics skills ready for Sports Day.</p>  |
| <p>RE Throughout the Summer Term in RE, we will be focusing on Christianity and answering the Big Question 'What do Christians believe God is like?' We will then move on to answering the Big Question 'How should we care for the world and for others, and why does it matter?'</p> | <p>Daily Reading at Home Each child has their own personal Oxford Owl login so they can access the Read Write Inc phonics book they are reading each week. This is the most important book to read at home. Children will also receive a book band levelled book as an alternative.</p> | <p>Spelling We will continue to send home spellings each week for your child to learn ready for their spelling quiz on a Tuesday. Please continue to support your child's learning by encouraging them to learn their spellings.</p> |
