We have arranged the following activities for your child:

- **Wednesday 8th July: Box Car Rally**

Year 6 have been given the opportunity to participate in a Box Car Rally at the world famous Shelsley Walsh Hill Climb track. We are aware that sadly, this year, this will clash with some high school transition days for some children. Only the children who are not on transition will be able to attend. This is an event that has been organised by the Rivers C of E Multi Academy Trust to bring Year 6 children together, from across our schools to participate in a day celebrating the skills and knowledge that they have learnt in Design and Technology. Children will be transported by coach. More details will be sent out nearer the time.
