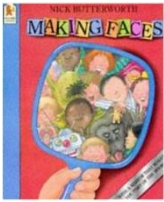
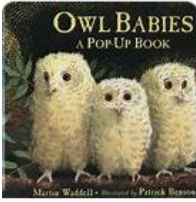
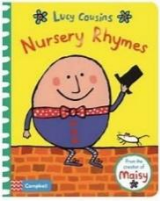




Burlish Park Primary Nursery

Book bags and reading diaries are checked daily by staff.	Writing/Mark making This term we will give the children many opportunities to develop their fine motor skills through various activities, such as playdough, cutting, creative activities, and mark-making in the different areas within the Nursery.	Maths This term we will be focussing on number and shape recognition. There will be many fun activities for the children to engage in, to help them learn their shapes and numbers. There will also be home activities for you to support your child with their learning.

We will also begin name writing and teaching the children the sounds that are in their names.

Please send these in as soon as possible.	PE PE sessions will be on Monday and Friday mornings. They will take place in the main school hall and will commence when we feel that the children have settled into Nursery. Please send your child to school in navy or black jogging bottoms/leggings and a white polo shirt for these sessions every week.
