## Nursery Admissions Policy 2020

Burlish Park Primary School is part of the Rivers Multi Academy Trust. Parents and guardians wishing to apply for a place must complete the Burlish Park Primary School Nursery enrolment form, available from the school office or website and it should be submitted directly to the school.

Acceptance for a Nursery place does not guarantee admission to the main school. Separate Main School online admissions requests will need to be made to Worcestershire County Council at the appropriate time and subject to the admission criteria at that time.

### Registration

- Applications are made directly to Burlish Park Primary School on the Nursery enrolment form available from the school website and office.
- Closing date for 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020 is 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020.
- Closing date for January 2021 and Easter 2021 are as follows:

Tuesday 5 <sup>th</sup> January 2021	Friday 23 <sup>rd</sup> October 2020
Monday 19 <sup>th</sup> April 2021	Thursday 11 <sup>th</sup> February 2021

- Parents for September 2020 will be advised if they have a place by 1<sup>st</sup> May 2020.
- Parents for other requested start dates will be advised if they have a place at least one month before their chosen start date.
- Parents have ten working days to confirm acceptance. If no acceptance is received by the school, the offer is withdrawn without further notice.
- A new offer will be made to any other child on our waiting list.
- Parents cannot defer a place once offered although their request can go forward with the next round of applications if desired and subject to the admissions criteria.
- If demand is high, applicants may be unsuccessful. They will be informed of this in the term before their child would have entered Nursery. They will then have the option of being placed on a waiting list.

### Admission Criteria

- An initial intake will allocate places to those children who will be 3 by 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020.
- Further intakes are then offered to children who will be 3 in the term they wish to join (spaces permitting).
- In each category listed above, priority is given in the order of options below:

Option 1	<i>For those eligible for 30 hour funding:</i> <b>Monday – Friday 8:50am-3pm</b>
Option 2	<i>For 3 year olds eligible for 15 hour funding, either:</i> <b>1. Monday and Tuesday, 8.50am – 3pm, Wednesday 8.50am – 11.50am</b> or <b>2. Wednesday 12.00pm – 3.00 pm, Thursday &amp; Friday, 8.50am – 3pm</b>



	<i>Extra sessions at available (spaces permitting) at £15.00 per half day session for children age 3 / £17.00 per half day session for children under 3.</i>
Option 3	Parents who would like to use funded childcare or pay for any sessions in any pattern. Please note these may be full days or half days depending on capacity. Paid sessions are at a cost of £15.00 per session or £17.00 per session for under 3s.

When admission to the Nursery is over-subscribed, applications for entry will be ranked according to the following criteria:

- “Looked after” children (as defined in the Education Act 2002 – Admissions)
- 30 hour placements (Option 1) for those children who live in the catchment area of this school who will have a sibling attending this primary school at the time of the applicant’s proposed admission, who are living at the same address as part of the same family unit.
- 15 hour placements (Option 2) for those children who live in the catchment area of this school who will have a sibling attending this primary school at the time of the applicant’s proposed admission, who are living at the same address as part of the same family unit.
- 30 hour placements (Option 1) for those children who live in the catchment area of this school.
- 15 hour placements (Option 2) for those children who live in the catchment area of this school.
- 30 hour placements (Option 1) for those children who live outside the catchment area of this school, with a sibling attending this school at the time of the applicant’s proposed admission.
- 15 hour placements (Option 2) for those children who live outside the catchment area of this school, with a sibling attending this school at the time of the applicant’s proposed admission.
- 30 hour placements (Option 1) for those children who live outside the catchment area of this school who live the nearest calculated in a direct straight line from the child’s permanent place of residence to the school.
- 15 hour placements (Option 2) for those children who live outside the catchment area of this school who live the nearest calculated in a direct straight line from the child’s permanent place of residence to the school.
- Option 3 or requests for below the 15 hours provision.

### **Funding Eligibility**

School offers a total of 30 hours and fifty minutes of free childcare per week, over 38 weeks (term time only)

**Burlish Park Primary do not offer stretched funding over 52 weeks. The funded hours must be used throughout the 38 weeks of term time only. Therefore, the funding cannot be used for any care during the school holidays.**

### **Attendance**

- We expect children to attend all booked sessions each week unless they are unwell.
- For safeguarding reasons, we may request proof of illness from parents of children who have higher than average level of absence due to illness (confirmation of GP appointment, prescription receipt etc.)
- If attendance falls below 85% the school reserves the right to remove the child from roll and offer the place to another child on the waiting list.

*There will be an annual review of this policy by Senior Leadership Team and a major review involving the School Improvement Board and Early Years staff will take place every three years.*
